

2021 ANNUAL SYMPOSIUM SAFETY PROTOCOL/REQUIREMENTS

Your health and safety are extremely important to us and we plan to do everything we can to make things safe and comfortable at the ATAA Symposium.

ATAA has been and will continue to monitor issues related to Covid-19 in Austin, Texas. While things are fluid and this may evolve over time to keep up with current best practices, this is the safety protocol that we are currently planning to follow for the 2021 Annual Symposium, September 23-25, 2021, at the Austin Marriott Downtown:

- Proof of vaccination or a negative Covid-19 test (within 72 hours of check in) will be required to attend the symposium. This will be checked at time of onsite check in for symposium.
- Masks will be required by all attendees, exhibitors and ATAA staff while in the meeting room space, exhibit hall, ballroom foyers and registration area. Masks should be worn properly over the nose and mouth. As of this date, the Austin Marriott staff are also required to mask. However, other than staff, there is no mask ordinance in effect at the hotel. There will be masks available at the registration desk if one is needed.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be placed throughout our contracted meeting space and available in all meeting rooms and the registration desk.

If you cannot attend the symposium in-person, all program sessions will be video recorded and available for viewing after the symposium. The price for viewing the recorded program is the same as the price for attending in person.

ATAA staff is in the process of applying for CLE accreditation for the recorded version of the symposium. While most states will accredit the recorded program, there may be a very few states that will not. ATAA cannot guarantee state CLE approval.

ATAA will keep you apprised of any changes related to this safety protocol between now and the time of the symposium.
